## THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "Do not be conformed to the world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind" (Romans 12:2). In the Bible *transformation* means change or renewal from a life that no longer conforms to the ways of the world to one that pleases God. This is accomplished by the renewing of our minds, an inward spiritual transformation that will manifest itself in outward actions. The Bible presents the transformed life in Christ as demonstrated through our bearing fruit in every good work and growing in the knowledge of God (Colossians 1:10). Transformation involves those who were once far from God being "drawn near" to Him through the blood of Christ (Ephesians 2:13). Evidence of transformation within us is seen in the way we increasingly reflect the likeness and glory of Christ.

Transformed lives begin with the gospel message of Christ, for in it is the power of God. Through the gospel, we put off our old self, to be renewed in the spirit of our minds, and then put on our new self. The goal of our transformation is to imitate Jesus in our new life. This new life begins in the gospel. The gospel itself is an imitation of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. Romans 6:4 teaches of how we imitate Christ's death through baptism. It goes on to say that we do this "in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life." There are many things we can do to enhance and grow in our new life; this new life in Christ which begins at baptism. Paul said it well in Galatians 2:20 when he said, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me."
