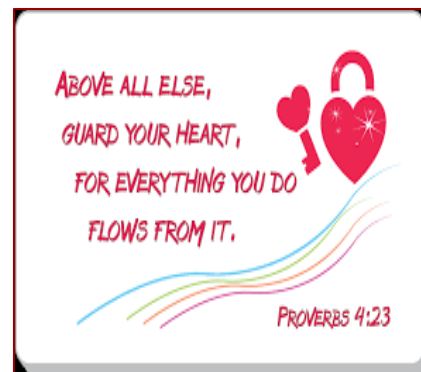
## THE BIBLE SAYS
