THE BIBLE SAYS

James said, "But the one who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does" (James 1:25). James refers to the Law of Christ, which includes the Gospel. It is a declaration of righteousness and salvation delivered by Jesus. It is an offer of peace and pardon by Him, and the gift of eternal life through Him. The juxtaposition of the contrasting terms "law" and "liberty" creates a self-explanation of the law. This is God's new covenant with His new people that is initiated and driven by the Grace of God and made manifest by His people.

The perfect law of liberty frees us from the heavy-laden law of Moses (the "old law") that could only lead to sin and death because of the weakness of humanity. Under this new law of liberty, Christ has fulfilled the debt required by the old covenant, freeing us from that burden of debt. Those who choose to follow Christ by faith are freed from the bondage of sin and its consequence.

Now, let us make no mistake, it is a law, the new covenant of Christ. James tells us to investigate the law of liberty and to not forget what we learn but to obey the law. Jesus said of the transition from the old law to this new law, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest...for my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light (Matthew 11:28-30)." What perfect liberty we now enjoy; to be redeemed (liberated) from the bondage of sin, so that we can faithfully follow the law of liberty in service to our Creator.
