THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "God called you to this through our Gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Corinthians 2:14). When we consider those who are the called by the Lord, we usually think of those who, universally, are invited to obey the Gospel. This is sometimes called the Gospel call because it is extended to everyone who hears the message. Jesus told the disciples to proclaim the Gospel to all creation. When the Gospel is proclaimed, those who hear are called to obey it, prompting a decision from them. Those who heed this call will be saved and those who do not will be condemned, (Mark 16:15-16).

A second use of "called" refers not to the invitation, but to the identity of those who have responded to the gospel in faith – those who have heard and answered the call in obedience. They are described as "the called," a title of those belonging to Christ. This use of the word emphasizes that God's call is not merely an event but a transforming reality that defines the Christian life. God's children are not just people who made a right decision – they are people whom God has claimed as His own. Paul said, "All things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are "the called..." (Romans 8:28).

The third biblical use of "called" refers to God summoning particular people to fulfill specific purposes, ministries, or works. Abraham was called to leave his homeland and become the father of a nation (Genesis 12:1-3). Moses was called to lead Israel out of Egypt (Exodus 3-4). Paul was called to be an apostle to the Gentiles (Romans 1:1). This kind of calling does not refer to salvation, but to service to God. Romans 12:6-8 teaches us that each member of the Lord's body has been given specific gifts, according to the grace God has given. And we are called to use those gifts. In these three different callings we see a picture of God designed sequence for our lives. He invites, He saves, and He sends.

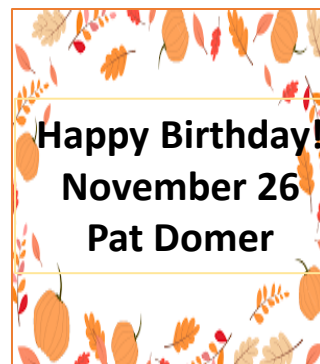
