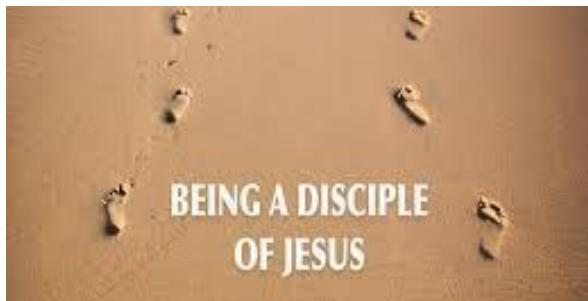

THE BIBLE SAYS

Jesus said, "Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples" (John 13:35). By definition, a disciple of Jesus is a person who follows Jesus Christ and accepts and assists in the spreading of the good news of salvation through Him. Jesus' disciples are asked to faithfully pursue God's desires, requiring much time in the Word of God. According to Bible, being a disciple of Jesus involves personal growth characterized by the following:

Putting Jesus first in all things (Mark 8:34–38). The disciple of Jesus needs to be set apart from the world. Our focus should be on our Lord and how to please Him in every area of our lives. We must put off self-centeredness and put on Christ-centeredness.

Following the teachings of God's Word (John 8:31–32). We must be obedient children of God and doers of the Word. Obedience is the supreme test of faith in God. Jesus said, "Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me" (John 14:21).

Bearing fruit (John 15:1–8). Jesus' disciples will live fruitful lives, displaying the fruit of the Spirit and good works. As we abide in Christ, and He abides in us, we will bear fruit.

Loving other disciples (John 13:34–35). Love of other believers is evidence of our being a member of God's family. To be able to show the kind of love Jesus speaks of is to think more highly of others than ourselves, and to look out for their interests above our own.

Making disciples of others (Matthew 28:18–20). One of the last things Jesus said to His disciples before His ascension was to "make disciples of all nations," "baptizing them," and "teaching them to obey."

A disciple of Jesus is one who puts Him first, obeys the Lord, produces good fruit, loves others, and makes more disciples. Such a disciple is certain to make an impact in this world for Christ.
