THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses" (1 Timothy 6:12). This verse is part of Paul's personal letter to Timothy. The "good confession" refers to a public declaration of faith. Interestingly, in the next verse, Paul mentions that Jesus also made a good confession: "In the sight of God, who gives life to everything, and of Christ Jesus, who while testifying before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, I charge you."

In John 18:37 we hear Jesus saying to Pilate, "You say that I am a king. In fact, the reason I was born and came into the world is to testify to the truth. Everyone on the side of truth listens to me." Here, "truth" refers not merely to a set of precepts, but when Jesus claimed to testify to the truth, He was testifying about Himself, for He is the Truth (John 14:6).

Thus, the good confession bears witness to Jesus. In Romans 10:9, we learn that a good confession plays an intricate role in the process of salvation. Our confession is not trite or inconsequential. It is a statement to the world and to God that we believe that Jesus is God's Son, our Savior, and not only the ruler of our lives, but the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords. These are words that one cannot unsay. They become contractual to all who hear them.

Paul reminds Timothy of this confession as he is charging him to keep the commands of "Fight the good fight of the faith," and "Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called." Followers of Jesus must always remember who they are and the confession they made in the sight of God. When our faith becomes challenged or exhausted, let us remind ourselves of our own good confession, refreshing our firm conviction and fervent zeal for Christ.
