## THE BIBLE SAYS

Jesus said, "You are my friends if you do what I command you" (John 15:14). A relationship with Jesus is the most important relationship a person can have. Having a relationship with Jesus is based on God's grace, through faith. To understand, we need to look at a few simple truths found in the Bible.

The first truth we need to recognize to have a relationship with Jesus is that, naturally, our relationship with God is broken due to our sin. God's standard is perfection—since He is absolutely holy—and we all fall short of that standard. "The wages of sin is death" (Romans 6:23). In this state, we find ourselves lost, separated from God, and in need of salvation.

Secondly, to have a relationship with Jesus, we also need to understand that God loves us despite our sins, and He sent His Son, Jesus Christ to die for us, as our substitute. He knew and we too must come to realize that there is absolutely nothing we can do to save ourselves from this lost condition. Because of the sacrifice of Jesus, God is willing to forgive our sins, saving us by His grace and through our faith in Him (Ephesians 2:8-9).

Our faith is what causes us to do the things that Jesus calls us to do as His followers. Jesus has made all of this known to us. He continues in John 15, "I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you." We must turn from our sin and place our faith in the fact that Jesus has made salvation possible. This faith then compels us to be obedient, and Jesus will call us His friend.
