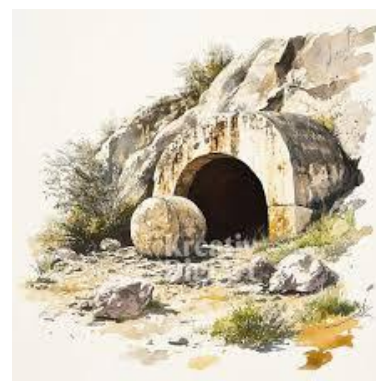
THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith" (1 Corinthians 15:14). There are numerous non-negotiable truths that are the foundations on which the faith of the Christian is built. But there are none that compare to the magnitude and importance of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. It is the crowning achievement that forever separates Jesus from any other religious leader who has ever been or will ever live. Roman rule brought crucifixion as a particularly heinous form of capital punishment. Many people were crucified for their crimes and for insulting Caesar. Although the crucifixion and burial of Jesus are central to Christian doctrine, they were not particularly remarkable within the context of the culture at that time. However, the bodies of those other people are still in their graves. Jesus' tomb is empty. If Jesus never rose from the dead, there would be no compelling reason to believe that He is who He said He is. But the fact is that He did rise again, confirming His claim to be God.

The fact that Jesus rose from the dead matters because our justification hinges on it. "He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification" (Romans 4:25). A dead Savior cannot save, but we have a living Savior who justifies us and makes intercession for us (Hebrews 7:25). The fact that Jesus rose from the dead is fundamental to our faith. Paul continues in 1 Corinthians 15, "if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile; you are still in your sins" and believers "are more to be pitied than anyone in the world." The fact that Jesus rose from the dead, conquering death, is the only thing that gives us hope in this life, because it gave Him the power to grant eternal life.
