THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "We know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose" (Romans 8:28). This promise does not mean God's people will be protected from the difficulties of this earthly life, but that all things together will ultimately lead to the completion of God's divine will. This is called divine providence. It is the governance of God by which He, with wisdom and love, cares for and directs all things in the universe. By His sovereignty He is over the universe, the physical world, the affairs of nations, human destiny, successes, failures, and protection. This doctrine stands in direct opposition to the idea that the universe is governed by chance or fate. It must be noted that part of God's providence is His working through nature. The laws of nature are nothing more than principles that God set in place to govern how things work. They are only "laws" because God decreed them. This allows God to govern indirectly.

There are instances in which God also works directly to accomplish His will. We must understand that God, by direct intervention, can do anything and everything to cause His will to be done. When God intervenes directly, lives of people and ways of nature may not be noticeably affected but affected they will be; and outcomes will align with His sovereign will. Humans, by the way, have free will only because God has designed it so. This is another example of God's wisdom. God is not the author of sin; He does not tempt anyone to sin (James 1:13); and He does not condone sin. However, He allows people to choose sin. If choosing sin were not an option, free will would not exist, eliminating the opportunity to choose God. Divine providence does not destroy our freedom. Rather, God, in His infinite wisdom, takes our freedom into account while sovereignly setting a course to fulfill His will.
