## THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ" (Galatians 6:2). The original word here translated "burden" means a weight or trouble not easily carried by one person. Let us first explore the contrast between this verse and verse 5 which says, "Each one should bear their own load." How can we bear someone else's burdens if we are each supposed to carry our own loads? The Greek word usually translated "load" refers to an individual burden that is not transferable. We each have certain obligations for which we alone are responsible. There are some responsibilities that are exclusively our own, such as personal obedience to God, moral choices and accountability, and stewardship of time, resources, and God-given gifts. We might say these are in a category of being faithful or unfaithful to God.

However, according to verse 2, we must be ready and willing to help others with burdens that become too difficult for a brother or sister in Christ to bear alone. This has the connotation of coming alongside them to help shoulder a weight that is threatening to pull them under. These burdens may come from grief and loss, serious illness or disability, financial hardship, emotional suffering or discouragement, temptations and spiritual struggles, unexpected crises, and being caught in a sin (verse 1).

Though most understand there is personal responsibility in life and in their relationship with God, others may endeavor to take advantage of fellow Christians who take this command very seriously. When a healthy, godly balance is sought and erring in one direction or the other is a concern, it is always more expedient to err on the side of mercy rather than on the side of judgement. When we all aim to bear our own loads, while always being available to bear one another's burdens when the need arrives, we will find the perfect balance in fulfilling the "law of Christ."

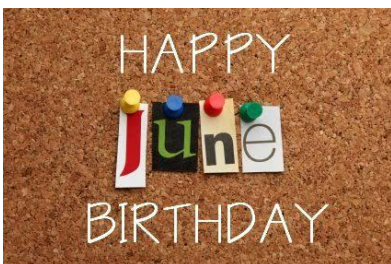
