THE BIBLE SAYS

Apostle Paul said, "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery" (Galatians 5:1). Believers' sins are forgiven on the basis of Christ's perfect sacrifice. Now believers can live in freedom from the law, and they can live in freedom from the consequences and power of sin. The occasion of Paul's letter to these Galatians was that false teachers had come into the churches there. They were promoting legalism and tried to require Christians to observe the civil, ritual, and ceremonial rules of the Old Law. Paul, in no uncertain terms, says that following these teachings would absolutely place Christians back under the yoke of slavery from which they had been set free.

Without Christ's sacrifice, we would still be living under bondage to the law. We would be burdened by demands we could not keep. Christ's death and resurrection broke that bondage. Only Christians have true freedom from the law. John 8:36 confirms, "If the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." In Christ, we are free from the oppressive nature of the Law of Moses and the penalty of sin. We are also free to live a life in honor of God for the precious gift of grace found in Jesus, and His Gospel. Jesus did what the law could not do. Paul explains in Romans 8:3, "What the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the sinful nature; God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man to be a sin offering." As Paul mentions above, it is now our responsibility to stand firm in our faith and live in a way that keeps us from falling back into slavery to sin.
