THE BIBLE SAYS

God Judges Our Secrets

Apostle Paul said, "This will take place on the day when God will judge our secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares" (Romans 2:16). There are things about every person that no one else knows. We may have thoughts we would never speak aloud, motives we would never admit, and actions we have carefully hidden from others. We can control what people see, what they hear, and even what they believe about us. But there is One from whom nothing can be hidden. God does not judge only what is visible. He sees beneath our words and actions and knows the thoughts and intentions of our hearts.

This is important because human judgment is limited. People can judge by what is apparent, but God sees the heart. We may convince others that everything is fine while privately holding on to bitterness, lust, pride, dishonesty, or resentment. We may receive praise from people for something that God knows was done with the wrong motive. The thought of God judging our secrets can be frightening, but it can also be encouraging. It means that God knows the whole story. He knows the good that others never notice. He sees the sacrifices that receive no recognition and the acts of faithfulness that no one else applauds. Nothing done for God is truly unseen.

At the same time, this truth reminds us that we cannot simply manage our appearance. Christianity is not about looking righteous. It is about actually being righteous before God. God knows who we really are. If God judges even our secrets, then none of us can stand before Him claiming that we have been perfect. We need the grace, mercy, and forgiveness found in Jesus Christ.

Therefore, we should live honestly before God. Repent of what needs to be changed. And remember that the God who sees our secrets is also the God who offers us mercy. One day, everything will be brought into the light. Until then, let us live so that what God knows about us matches what others see in us.
